Stabilizing kittens and immediate critical care

Performing an intake exam – what to look for/how to do it/what's needed

Care for orphaned kittens (proper housing, feeding and daily care)

Socializing kittens and feral kittens

Common concerns (singles, genital suckling, putting w/ nursing queen, putting w/ other kittens)

Pregnancy and delivery (including delivery complications)

Symptoms of various diseases and available diagnostic testing

Treatment protocols for various diseases (including medication options to fit large and small budgets)

Internal and External parasites (recognition, diagnostics, treatment options)

Ringworm (symptoms, diagnosis, treatments)

Diarrhea (causes, treatments)

Eye issues and treatment options

Building and using a nebulizer to treat upper respiratory infections and pneumonia

How to safely bathe young kittens

How to set up and/or expand a foster program

How to set up and/or expand a nursery program (w/in shelter or as separate nursery)

Establishing and maintaining medical records and veterinary relationships

Cost-saving tips throughout the day as they relate to the various workshop topics
