



## Topics Presented in Full-Day Workshops\*

Care for orphaned kittens (proper housing, feeding and daily care)

Common concerns (singles, genital suckling, putting with nursing queen, putting with other kittens)

Appropriate housing for kittens of all ages, singles, litters, queens with kittens (including how to lower stress while sheltered and eliminating potential hazards)

Social and behavioral development for kittens and feral kittens

Pregnancy and delivery (including dealing with complications)

Care for the pregnant or nursing queen and her kittens

Nutrition (including supplements/nutraceuticals)

Stabilizing kittens and immediate critical care

Performing a basic physical exam (what to look for, how to do it, what's needed)

Early recognition of diseases and proactive supportive care

Symptoms of various diseases and available diagnostic testing

Treatment protocols for various diseases (including medication options to fit large and small budgets)

Internal and external parasites (recognition, diagnostics, treatment options)

Ringworm (symptoms, diagnosis, treatments)

Diarrhea (causes, treatments)

Eye issues and treatment options

Quarantine and ways to minimize or eliminate disease transmission

Cleaning and sanitation protocols

How to safely bathe young kittens

Vaccines and vaccination protocols

Building and using a nebulizer to treat upper respiratory infections and pneumonia

Helping kittens transition well in their new home (preparing for transition and helping adopters, too)

How to set up and/or expand a foster program

How to set up and/or expand a nursery program (within a shelter or as a separate nursery)

Establishing and maintaining medical records and veterinary relationships

Cost-saving tips throughout the day as they relate to the various workshop topics

Time for questions and answers throughout the workshop and via email afterwards
