

HOOKED ON KITTENS: A FOSTER'S STORY

"I've loved cats for as long as I can remember. And, kittens, well there's nothing cuter. So, when I retired and moved to a small, rural mountain town in western Colorado, I knew I'd foster kittens.

"Kittens, especially those too young to eat on their own or too young for adoption, are one of the largest groups of animals euthanized in animal shelters. They have under developed immune systems and most shelters, no matter how wonderful,

can't provide the care kittens need to thrive. That's why trained fosters -- and the work of the National Kitten Coalition -- are so important. NKC has been a pioneer in training and providing educational materials to animal shelter staff, rescue groups, veterinary communities, volunteers and fosters to provide high-quality, cost-effective kitten care.

"Thanks to the daylong NKC workshop I attended, I had the confidence to be a kitten foster and jumped at the chance to foster a very pregnant tuxedo cat, Juno, when my local shelter asked. Juno grew bigger and bigger with each day until finally, on the morning of the 6th day, we heard squeals behind the foster room door. Juno's five kittens were blissfully nursing.


"Juno was a wonderful mom and I couldn't wait to wake up every morning to see Flint, Gizmo, Nugget, Dotty and Licorice. I constantly referred to NKC's information on the physical and behavioral development of kittens and marveled at each milestone.

"When they were eight weeks old, it was time to return the family to the shelter so they could be spayed or neutered and adopted. Saying goodbye was bittersweet, but it meant I could foster two more litters that spring and summer.

"Fostering is one of the most rewarding experiences I've ever had. NKC has litter-ally been a lifesaver. Tell your animal shelters and rescue groups about NKC's training and resources. Together, we can make our little corner of the world a better place for animals - especially kittens."
