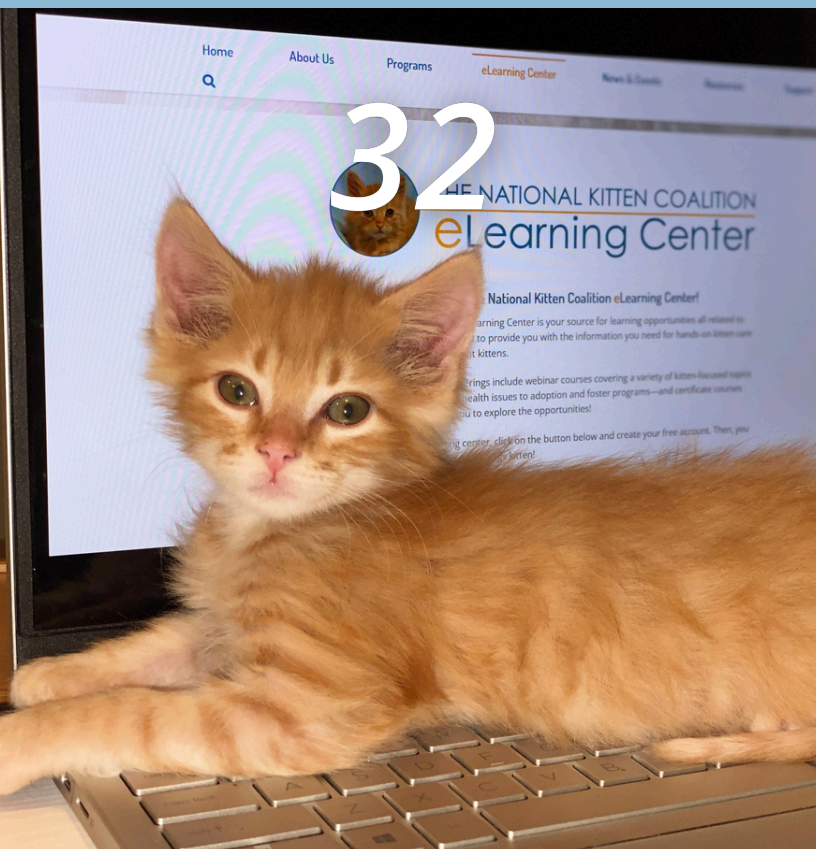
2024 IMPACT REPORT

Increasing survival rates of kittens

STUDENTS

We reached at least 2,168 individuals with our online educational programs. Our webinar and conference attendees included animal care professionals at shelters and rescue organizations, members of the veterinary community, volunteers who foster kittens, and individuals who have never cared for kittens before but wanted to learn.

TEACHING EVENTS

We hosted 12 webinars, and presented or organized 20 kitten-centered presentations at online or in-person conferences, including the Online Kitten Conference and our fifth NKC Veterinary Conference, with participants from around the world.

KITTENS IMPACTED

In surveys, attendees estimated they care for on average at least 52 kittens every year, which suggests that the National Kitten Coalition's educational programs impacted at least 112,032 kittens in 2024.
